How To Leave A

GIFT TO OPEN DOORS

STEP ONE

Choose what type of legacy you would like to leave:

– **A Cash Bequest:**

A specific sum of money.

– **A Percentage Of Your Estate:**

A specific percentage of your estate's total value.

– **A Residuary Gift:**

The remainder of your estate after you have taken care of your family and friends.

STEP TWO

Speak to family and loved ones.

Let your family and loved ones know of your intentions to leave a gift to Open Doors.

STEP THREE

Seek professional advice.

Visit a solicitor to write or update your Will.

About Open Doors Taxation Cash Bequests

The full title of the organisation is “Open Doors (New Zealand) Incorporated” (herein “Open Doors”).

Taxation

Open Doors is a tax-exempt body under Section CW41 of the Income Tax Act 2007.

Cash Bequests

Gifts of money are simpler to administer if in cash, and so we would encourage that any gifts be provided in that form. The following wording would be suitable for the provision of a cash bequest:

“I give to Open Doors, (% of my estate, the residue of my estate, or a specific sum of money, property or assets – here described) for a specific ministry purpose (for example, a specific country in need, bible distribution, children’s or women’s ministry – please call us if you would like to discuss a specific area of ministry).

Alternatively choose to leave your gift to the discretion of Open Doors so it can contribute to an area, people, or ministry most at need: for which the receipt of an authorised officer of the Open Doors shall be a whole and sufficient discharge for my estate’s trustees.”

Continued...

A Percentage Of Your Estate

If the subject of your gift is in the form of real estate or shares or other property, then the following is a possible form of wording for the Solicitor's consideration:

"I direct that my Executor sell [name of asset] and after the payment of all expenses for such sale and the payment of any Taxes thereon, my Executor shall pay the net proceeds of the sale [or a percentage thereof] to Open Doors to be used for such purposes as the Board of Open Doors may, in its absolute discretion AND I declare that the receipt by an appointed officer of Open Doors shall be a full and sufficient discharge for my Executor."

A Residuary Gift

Alternatively, after making specific provision for the members in the Will, you may choose to leave the balance (the Residuary Estate) to Open Doors. Again, subject to the advice of the Solicitor on any Capital Gains Tax aspects, the following wording would be suitable:

"I direct that my Executor shall pay the residue of my Estate to Open Doors AND the receipt of an appointed officer of Open Doors shall be a full discharge for my Executor."
